This term's project title is: How I can Help my Local Environment

With Covid restrictions hopefully allowing children the opportunity to bring more things in and out of school we are reintroducing the opportunity for children to participate in undertaking a project. *It will be* based on the class topic, but they will be free to focus in greater detail on a specific area that they wish to explore further. In class we will be focussing on a local study of the area, looking at land use, map work, a field study and how the area has changed over time. We are asking the children to extend this within their project work by looking at how they might improve their local environment. Perhaps they could plan and design a better playground using recyclable materials...more recycling points...better insulated homes using less energy to heat them in the winter... or maybe they want to divert the road and make Woburn a cycle and walk town with no cars...

The children will be expected to undertake some written element of the topic, but this can be enhanced with models, art work, poetry, song, drama...whatever inspires them.

Topic Work needs to be handed in by: Friday 10th December, giving us plenty of opportunity for them to share their work with the rest of the school.
