Remote Learning Plan

In order to ensure that learning is continued, irrespective of lockdown and self-isolation, Woburn Lower School has developed the following plan.

This plan will be applied in the following instances:

- A child is self-isolating because of a positive test within the household
- A class of children are self-isolating because of an outbreak of coronavirus in their bubble
- The whole school is self-isolating because of an outbreak of coronavirus within the school or a local/national lockdown

This plan complies with the expectations and principles outlined in the DFE documents Guidance for full opening of schools and Remote Education good practice

Communication with Parents/Carers	Class 'dojo', email and telephone conversations to be used to communicate with parents.
Reading	Online reading to continue through Phonics Bug, also encouraging parents to read a variety of books at home and engage in different purposes for reading ie: reading a recipe.
Phonics	Online phonics to continue through Phonics Bug – games and reading books. Class teachers may also send supplementary work. Class teachers will ensure that all children are working at their correct level at home. Weekly video's recorded and sent home.
Writing	Writing skills will be developed through Oak academy and bite size, supplementary writing activities and tasks set by teachers. Recordings, zoom, google meet and google classrooms may be used by teachers.
Maths	Purple mash will be used for mathematical development, along-side Oak academy resources, bite size and supplementary maths activities and tasks set by teachers. Recordings, zoom, google meet and google classrooms may be used by teachers.

Science	Science to be taught through Oak academy, bite size, espresso, purple mash and supplementary activities and tasks set by teachers. Recordings, zoom, google meet and google classrooms may be used by teachers,
PE and Sports	Future Games professional sports coaches to conduct on-line PE lessons, supplementary PE and sports tasks set by teachers, engagement with activities set up by Leighton Linlode School Games
Foundation Subjects	To be taught through Oak academy and bite size resources, espresso, purple mash and supplementary activities and tasks set by teachers. Recordings, zoom, google meet and google classrooms may be used by teachers.
Assemblies	Weekly assemblies will be held via zoom.

We aim to teach the same curriculum remotely as we do in school. At Woburn Lower School we value a broad and balanced curriculum. Our lessons will include all Foundation subjects as well as the core maths, English and science lessons. The lessons in Foundation Subjects will encourage creativity and time away from the computer screen where possible.

Should remote education be necessary parents will be given further details of provision and how to access it. Dialogue between parents and the school will be continuous and the provision of remote learning will be closely monitored and adjusted if necessary. The school SENDco (Mrs Grant) will talk individually to parents of children with special needs.

The school will ensure that all children have online access and resources at home.
