The PDA Position Statement

Parent carers can help to identify problems frequently experienced by families who have children & young people with SEND.

It was bought to SNAP's attention, that for children & young people who presented with extreme demand avoidance / PDA, along with their families, there were challenges in having there needs recognised and met across education, health and social care.

SNAP proposed that a PDA position statement maybe an appropriate way forward and that Parent Carer participation in the process was required, due to the expertise they could bring to the table due to their lived experience.





The PDA Position Statement

Coproduced in collaboration with SNAP PCF and professionals across education, health and social care sectors in Central Bedfordshire and recognises the need for extra support to children/ young people and families with PDA.

The statement also had input from a young person with PDA

Launched on the local offer and disseminated across the locality just prior to PDA Day on the 15th May 2021

15th May 2021: PDA Day, hosted by the PDA Society. The position statement was promoted by the Society across their social media channels

Locality PDA Training & Education

Suggestions put forward by SNAP PCF to address the lack of understanding in the local area regarding PDA included a training package for professionals

SNAP PCF have coproduced in the first instance, a training package with the objective that professionals and parents would have equal knowledge in how to recognise and support PDA – due to commence in Nov 2021

SNAP PCF have already held some parent training from the PDA Society which was well received, and this is now the initial training package for professionals.





Diagnosis Support Pack (DSP)

A coproduced support pack for families following a diagnosis of neurodiveristy, involving parents, young people, SNAP PCF, Cambridgeshire Community Services NHS Trust, CAMHS, Educational Psychology and other key partners

A 'one –stop shop 'containing information, resources & signposting in a variety of media

14 different sections including positives of neurodiversities, lived experiences, sleep, medication, sensory processing needs, mental health and lots more





Diagnosis Support Pack (DSP)

The pack aims to uplift and celebrate neurodiversity

Has received interest from NHS England – Improvement (NHSEI) in looking at whether the pack can be progressed and used as a national resource

The work has been presented nationally at Royal College College of Paediatrics and Child Health
