

### **Foundation Subjects**

As Historians, we will be finding out about the origins of space travel. As we expand on this timeline, we will look at space travel today, and space travel in the future.

As Geographers, we will be looking at where we live, and what surrounds us.

As Artists, we will be using a range of materials to produce images of planets and our visions of alien life.

As Design Technologists we will design and make models of rockets and 3D Christmas crafts.

Our focus in Computing will be staying safe on the Internet. We will also use ICT to present and enhance our work from other curriculum areas.

### **Spiritual and Moral**

As part of our spiritual and moral development we will continue to build our knowledge about different faiths and beliefs through RE lessons, class discussions and assemblies. The children will look at the Jigsaw scheme of work in PSHE. The children will focus on ways of keeping safe and healthy.



### **Science**

As scientists we will be exploring outer space.

Investigating different aspects of Space, such as the Solar System, the phases of the moon and gravity.

We will also focus on mini beasts.

### **English**

We will develop our English skills using the techniques in the Talk4Writing scheme. We will be looking at Simon Bartram's Man on the Moon, as well as other stories and non-fiction reports on the moon landings. To help us write our own stories and factual reports, we will work on grammar, handwriting and phonics.

### **Mathematics**

As mathematicians we will look at place value, addition and subtraction and shape. As well as this we will complete a mental maths test once a week to work on our mental arithmetic.
