French lessons will continue to develop the children's vocabulary and their ability to ask and respond to questions

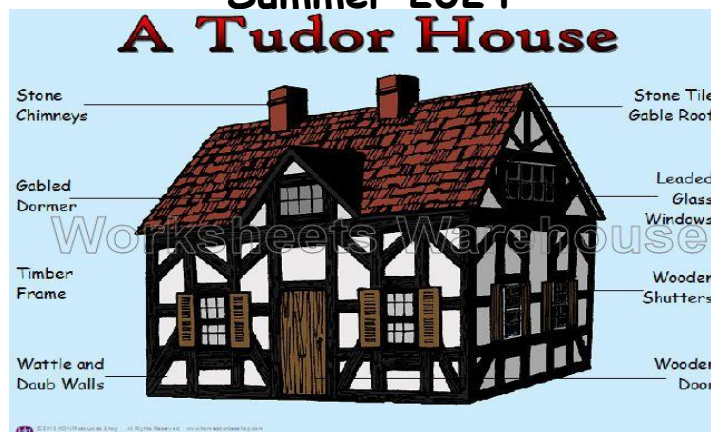
There will be the PGL trip for Year 4 children!

Maths: As mathematicians we will focus on gaining a clear understanding of data, measure and whilst year 4 focus on decimals and percentages, year 3 will have more opportunity to look at time and fractions. The Year 4s have been practicing their times tables ready for the assessment in the summer and the year 3s are becoming more adept at them too!
