

THE WORLD & ITS WEATHER

Foundation Subjects:

As Geographers we will look at the main countries and cities of the UK, as well as climates further afield. We will explore our local area using Google Maps and research weather patterns and extreme weather conditions in the wider world.

As Artists we will be producing our own seasonal and weather – related pictures. We will use a variety of mediums, including watercolours and pastels.

Our focus in Computing will be looking at coding. We will use ICT to present and enhance our work from other curriculum areas.

In Design and Technology, we will be designing and creating flood resistant model houses and making food for our annual tea party with Owls class.



Mathematics:

As mathematicians we will be working with numbers to 50 and beyond. We will be focusing on fractions, addition, subtraction, time, statistics, multiplication and division. We will also look at capacity and reading scales.

Science:

As scientists we will be looking at wild weather, and food chains as well as continuing our work on seasonal changes.

English:

Continuing with Talk4Writing, we will start the new term by creating our own non-chronological reports. During the second half term we will be looking at the story 'The Green Ship'. To help us write our own stories and factual reports we will work on grammar, handwriting and phonics.

Spiritual & Moral:

As part of our spiritual and moral development we will explore 'Healthy Me' in the latest section of our Jigsaw PSHE scheme. This will focus on keeping ourselves fit, healthy and safe.

In RE we will be looking at Christianity, Islam and Judaism.
